

Appointment Checklist

- Arrive 10 minutes early for preliminary vision tests
- Complete and bring the Patient History Form (*applies to New and Returning patients*)

- Bring all prescription eyeglasses that you routinely use
 - reading glasses
 - sunglasses
 - computer glasses
 - driving glasses
- Bring Sunglasses
Expect your eyes to be **dilated** as part of your thorough eye health exam. The dilation eyedrops can cause mild reading blur and light sensitivity lasting 2-3 hours. Those who wear reading glasses or bifocals are minimally affected. If you require an additional appointment to postpone your dilation, additional fees may be assessed.

Contact Lenses Wearers - if you intend to update or obtain a contact lens prescription

- Please WEAR your current contacts for at least 1 hour prior to your appointment.

NEW PATIENTS :

- Bring your **current contact lens packaging** or **prescription**. This will make your contact lens assessment more efficient, reduce your chair time, and reduce the cost of the contact lens evaluation fee.

You can make your eye appointment as productive and efficient as possible by being prepared for it.
